IS YOUR DOG SAFE FROM PARVO?

Parvovirus is a common killer of puppies & young dogs in Aotearoa.

It causes vomiting, bloody diarrhoea and death.

The virus is highly contagious and can survive in the environment for 12 months.

VACCINATION PROTECTS YOUR DOG FROM PARVO VIRUS & STOPS THE SPREAD!

Puppies should be vaccinated every 3-4 weeks between 6 and 16 weeks of age then again at 6-12 months. Adult dogs are vaccinated every 3 years.
